 - 3. <u>Under no circumstances will a supplementary test be arranged for students who cannot</u> take the placement test on the date above.

- 4. For students who wish to take any language courses coded JASP 4XXX:

 They MUST contact the responsible teacher of the course in person.

 (Please note that placement tests of courses JASP 4XXX MAY BE conducted SEPARATELY).
- 5. Students who have passed Japanese-Language Proficiency Test Level 4 / N5 or have documents to prove he / she got equivalent Japanese Language Level (with the approval of JAS Department) can apply for any language courses coded JASP 2450 directly.

 They do not have to attend placement test on condition that they must submit a copy of the Certificate of the Japanese-Language Proficiency Test Level 4 / N5 to the Department of Japanese Studies. - 6. Students who have passed Japanese-Language Proficiency Test Level 3 / N4 or above can apply for any language courses coded JASP 3XXX (ie. JASP 3070, 3350, 3390 BUT EXCEPT for JASP 3340. Students who wish to take JAS 3340 MUST attend the placement test). They do not have to attend placement test on condition that they must submit a copy of the Certificate of the Japanese-Language Proficiency Test Level 3 / N4 to the General Office of Department of Japanese Studies.
