# MPhil-PhD in Japanese Studies

## **Programme Information**

The objective of the programme is to encourage the advancement of research in Japanese studies by offering graduate training that accommodates a range of academic concerns in the field. The programme will focus on historical and socio-cultural aspects of Japan-China and Japan-Hong Kong relations from such disciplines as anthropology, history, popular culture, linguistic, philosophy, media studies, literature and international relations.

This programme is mainly for candidates who seek to study for a PhD degree as their ultimate goal.

#### **MPhil Stream**

Students are required:

- 1. To complete 12 units of lecture courses
- 2. To register for thesis research courses each term
- 3. To complete the MPhil thesis and pass the oral examination

Students with good academic performance in their first year of study can apply to be transferred to the PhD stream.

#### PhD Stream

Students are required:

- 1. To complete 12 units of lecture courses in the pre-candidacy stage
- 2. To register for thesis research courses each term
- 3. To pass the candidacy examination
- 4. To complete the PhD thesis and pass the oral examination

#### **Tuition Fee**

HK\$42,100 per annum regardless of the study mode

#### **Admission Requirements**

In addition to the general requirements of the Graduate School,

- 1. applicants are required to submit a 5-page proposal written in English (including research topic, research summary, previous research regarding the topic, methodology employed and references). Applicants may be required to attend an interview.
- 2. Japanese language proficiency requirements may vary according to the areas of study and the content of the research proposal and is to be decided by the Graduate Panel.
- 3. applicants are encouraged to submit one to two academic writing sample(s) in English, Chinese or Japanese (if any).
