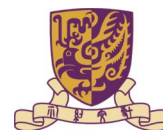

什麼是日本研究？

What is Japanese Studies?

從最基本的層面來說，日本研究使學生能夠全面了解日本的文化、歷史、社會與政治。透過深入研究日本的國家、地區及地方性脈絡，學生不僅能加深對日本的理解，還能啟發他們對當今世界的思考。在跨學科的學習環境中，學生們能夠不斷探討和反思一些被視為理所當然的觀點。此外，在學習過程中，學生更能逐漸掌握日語的流利運用。

日本研究課程不僅旨在教授學生有關日本的知識，更培養他們的好奇心、創造力、同理心及批判性思維，使本系畢業生能成為終身學習者。我們相信，學術研究是培養世界公民的一個重要途徑。

Japanese Studies enables students to gain a comprehensive understanding of Japan's culture, history, society, and politics. Through in-depth exploration of national, regional, and local contexts, students not only deepen their knowledge of Japan but are also inspired to reflect on the contemporary world. In an interdisciplinary learning environment, students are encouraged to continuously question and reflect on commonly held viewpoints that are often taken for granted. Additionally, throughout the learning process, they gradually develop fluency in the Japanese language.

Japanese Studies programme is not only designed to teach students about Japan, but also to cultivate their curiosity, creativity, empathy, and critical thinking skills—qualities that empower our graduates to become lifelong learners. We believe that academic study is a vital pathway to nurturing global citizens.

一年制交換生計劃

One-Year Exchange Programme



本系提供的一年制的交換生計劃，為修讀四年制課程的學生提供了在日本著名大學學習和生活的寶貴機會。學生可根據其學術和文化興趣，在日本多所大學中選擇心儀的大學參與交換生計劃。

在交流期間，學生將根據其日語水平學習日語，並與當地及其他國際學生一同修讀不同的課程。此外，學生還可以參加主辦大學社團及文化和社交活動，以發展個人興趣。

交換生計劃讓學生以當地居民和學生的身份，深入體驗日本的日常生活。這寶貴的經歷能有助深入理解當地人的生活方式和想法、提升日語能力，並學習與當地居民溝通所需的禮儀和社交技巧。

The one-year exchange programme offered by the Department of Japanese Studies provides students in the four-year curriculum with the opportunity to experience student life at a major university in Japan. Students may choose from a range of universities across Japan according to their academic and cultural interests, and in diverse geographic areas.

During their exchange, students will study Japanese language according to their proficiency level and may take courses with local and other international students. Students may also join university clubs to pursue their interests and participate in cultural and social programmes organized by their host university.

This immersive exchange experience allows students to live not as tourists, but as local residents and active members of the university community. As a result, they gain a deeper understanding of Japanese lifestyles and perspectives, develop strong language fluency, and acquire the social skills and cultural awareness essential for lifelong engagement with Japanese society.

日本文化祭是中大日本研究學系的傳統活動，由系會每年三月主辦，為期兩日，已有20多年歷史。

每年日本文化祭由同學自訂主題，設有多種攤位活動，包括傳統文化體驗、日式攤位遊戲等。此外，同學會自行設計製作的紀念品和小吃及飲品等售賣，是同學們展示才華和合作精神，深入沈浸日本文化的校園活動。

With a history of over 20 years, the Japanese Cultural Festival (Bunkasai) is a well-established tradition organized by the Japanese Studies Society every March. Each year, students set a unique theme featuring booth activities such as traditional cultural experiences and Japanese-style games. Students also design souvenirs and sell snacks and beverages. It is a campus event where students showcase their talents, cooperative spirit, and immerse themselves in Japanese culture.

Future Career Prospects

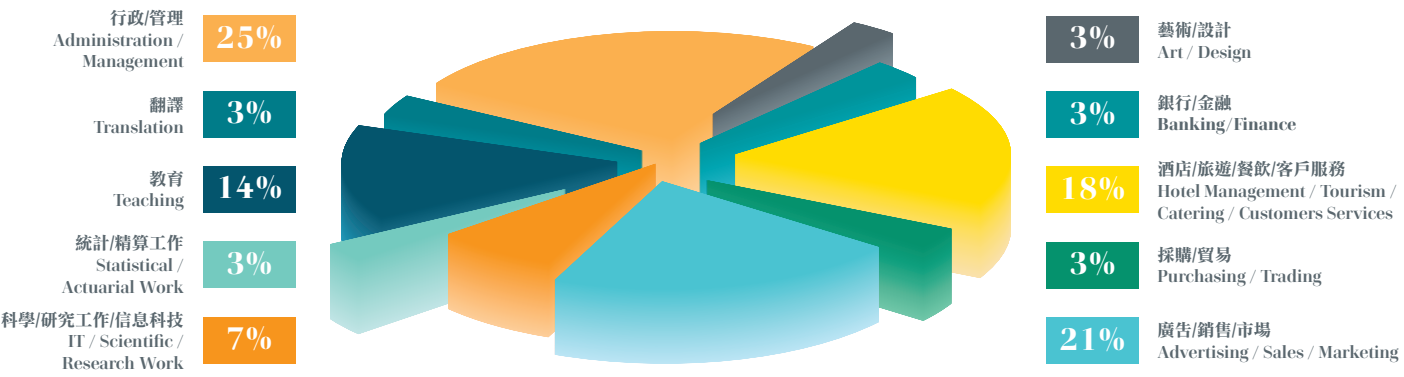
大部分日本研究學系畢業生會在商界、教育界及政府相關行情開展他們的事業。有部分畢業生會繼續學業或尋找其他機會。
